## **Schedule Overview**

**January-February:** Small group training: Players participate in small group training, usually a group of 4-5 players per instructor, 45 minutes hitting, 45 minutes pitching, once per week, usually on the weekends.

**March-May:** Team practice, once per week, Sundays 4-6, designed not to interfere with their Little League or Pony team schedule.

**June-1**<sup>st</sup> week of August: Practice 3 times per week, once their league teams are done. If players make their all-star team, they are not expected to attend Huskies practice.

There can be practice games scheduled during the practice dates.

**Tournaments:** Teams play 5 tournaments

**9u,10u:** 4<sup>th</sup> week of March, Memorial Day Weekend in Bellevue, then the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of July, 3<sup>rd</sup> week of July and 1<sup>st</sup> week of August.

**11u, 12u:** Play either 3<sup>rd</sup> week of March, 1<sup>st</sup> week in June and or the same as 9u and 10u, or 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> week of July and the first 2 weekends of August.

**Player Fee:** \$875. Payments and partial scholarships available upon request. We have one short, simple fundraiser, in order to keep player fees low, they do not cover all costs of operating each team.
