The Eastside Huskies are a group of competitive tournament teams that provide an opportunity for dedicated players and families to grow as a player and most importantly as a person to achieve the highest level of skill development and performance possible, within the context of their age group.

Character development is as important as performance on the field, as baseball will end someday, the opportunity to display great character will not.

Schedule:

January-February: Small group training: Players participate in small group training, usually a group of 4-5 players per instructor, 45 minutes hitting, 45 minutes pitching, once per week, usually on the weekends.

March-May: Team practice, once per week, usually Sundays 4-6, designed not to interfere with their Little League or Pony team schedule.

June-1st week of August: Practice 3 times per week, once their league teams are done. If players make their all-star team, they are not expected to attend Huskies practice.

There can be practice games scheduled during the practice dates.

Tournament Schedule: Teams play 5 tournaments: Spring-end of July

Player Fee: \$1,450. Payments and partial scholarships available upon request. We have one short, simple fundraiser, in order to keep player fees low, they do not cover all costs of operating each team.
